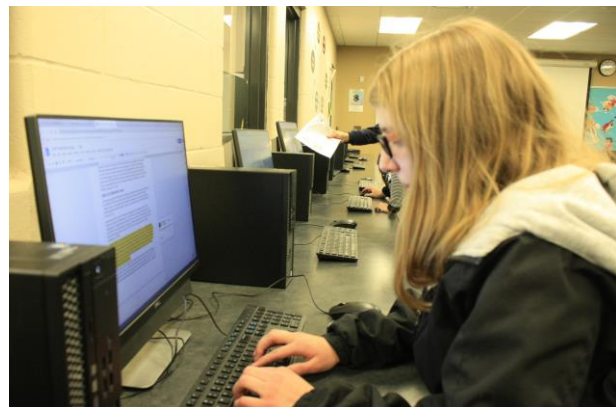
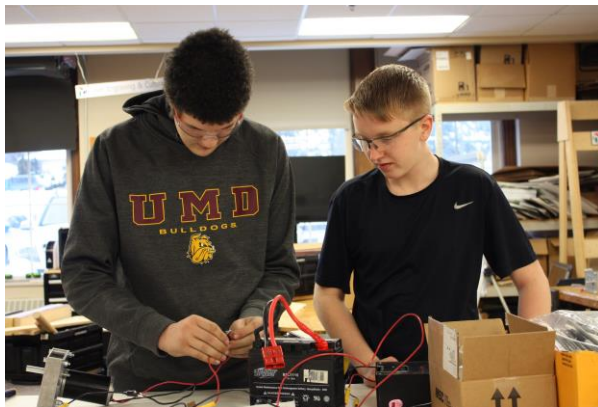
Denfeld Nation Automation (DNA) Update for Week 4
