We are very excited to be in the 2021 build season! In order to keep up with our progress, make sure to check out our social media sites and stay tuned for the following weekly updates.

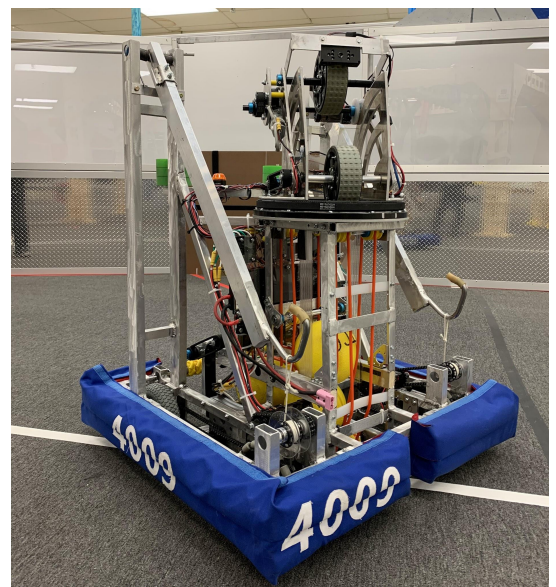
